It's not too late to donate items if you haven't done so already. Any remaining donations can be sent into school with pupils tomorrow (Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> September).

Here's a reminder of the items particularly welcomed:

#### Batley Food Bank

- Tinned goods - meat, fish, halal and meat-free alternatives, soup, baked beans, vegetables, fruit, rice pudding, custard.
- Packet goods - pasta, rice, noodles, cereals, biscuits.
- Sundry Items - tea, coffee, fruit squash, long life milk and cartons, pasta sauce jars, jam.
- Toiletries - toilet roll, soap/shower gel, deodorant, sanitary products  
(NB food must have a best before date of at least +6 months - April 2022)

#### Heckmondwike Rainbow Baby Bank

- Nappies (particularly size 3, 4 and 5), baby wipes, nappy sacks
- Toiletries for babies and children e.g. shampoo, baby bath, toothbrushes and toothpaste (especially for ages 0-2yrs).
- Toiletries for new mums (especially breast pads and maternity sanitary towels)
